At PL United Methodist Church, 1984 Sunset Cliffs Blvd., O.B.

Mike Martino, who is a Lifeguard Superviser at Silver Strand State Beach, will present the story of the May 5, 1918, Ocean Beach drownings. He will give analysis and examine some of the characters involved the tragic event.

This sad chapter in Ocean Beach's history occurred when a large rip current formed off Ocean Beach devastated the community, thirteen people drown including eleven servicemen. Others thought to be missing, but not confirmed. Multiple rescues were performed by lifeguards, police, and military along with civilians. Rescue operations spanned over three hours.

Mike has written the book the *Lifeguards of San Diego County* published by Arcadia. He also wrote A Baker's Dozen by the LawGiver a book of short stories about his work. Both books were San Diego Book awards finalists in 2007.


