

Unfortunately, photographs, house plans, business & organization records, and family papers end up in the trash after a death in the family. The cliffs erode and scenery changes. The OBHS Archives provide an invaluable window into O.B.'s past.

When donating photographs to the Archives, please remember to date, identify the people and places in them.


