THE CARLSON & HIGGINS O.B. SCANDALS

In 1887 Billy Carlson and Frank Higgins (credited as the founders of O.B.) renamed "Mussel Beds" to "Ocean Beach". Following that they were linked to numerous scandals. To name a few: land deals, an O.B. hotel and trains. Later Carlson became San Diego's youngest Mayor; while Higgin's became a tragic figure.



The Archives Room is in the PLUM Church in O.B., where the OBHS programs are held.

The collection includes: Photos, maps, books, papers, newspapers, letters, artifacts and an extensive biography index and San Diego City Directories from 1926 to 1984 (which list people, their spouses & occupations). Residents are also listed by street address. Dedicated volunteers assist with processing.
