The *OB Rag* was an alternative grassroots **I** newspaper for Ocean Beach during the • first half of the 1970s with its first publisher, editor & writer Frank Gormlie. It published from late Summer 1970 to early 1976. The



Rag's volunteer and dedicated activist staff succeeded in fueling the community organizing in O.B. during those vears with their underground publication, taking on the establishment while giving voice to the burgeoning counter-

The OB Rag blog and website was first initiated by Frank Gormlie & Patty Jones in late Oct. 2007. Their original intent was to ply • the San Diego scene with news and commentary • from a distinctively progressive and grassroots perspective, and to also provide a forum for those views.

The *OB Rag* also provides a web platform for the Ocean Beach California 92107 community, OB residents, merchants, and covers local OB and Point Loma news, issues • and events – and more.
